A historic relay race for teams of three athletes from UKA affiliated clubs:

- Each leg (of three) is approximately 2.7 miles and includes a hill which is a frequent topic of conversation at the end of the race!
- Each team of three must include a veteran (age 35+) and a woman (these may be the same person).
- Showering/changing facilities are available.
- Parking space is limited so please share cars and **park with consideration for local residents.**
- This is a closed race, limited to teams from local UKA affiliated clubs only.
- Entries will be limited to a maximum of **six teams per club until the initial closing date of Tuesday 9th June 2026.**

After this date, if spaces remain, then a further announcement will be made and any remaining places will be offered to clubs that have expressed an interest – clubs will be contacted via email.

- Team members should be nominated in advance* but can be amended up to (and including) the race day. Teams must be confirmed thirty minutes before the start. **No new team entries on the night.**
- Minimum age of runners: 18 years of age.
- There will be an official photographer at the event, please inform the race organisers if you don't wish to be photographed.
- The **entry fee** for the race this year is **£18** per team. **£3** from every entry going to our selected charity, which this year is COCO (<https://www.coco.org.uk/>). COCO do valuable work providing sustainable sources of quality education to children living in poor and marginalised communities amongst other projects.

Prizes

There are running voucher prizes for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd fastest teams; and novelty prize bags which are given to randomly selected teams at the end of the evening.
